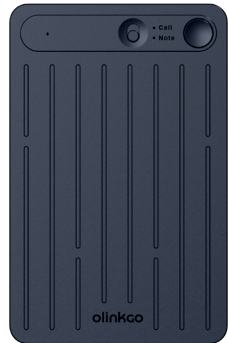

4. Connecting to the App

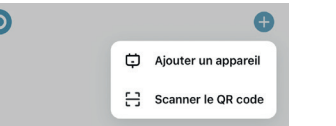
Step 1: Download the Olinkgo Note app

You can scan the QR code below to download the app, or search for “Olinkgo Note” on the App Store or Play Store.

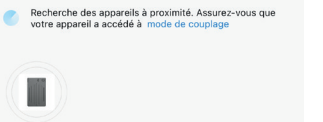


Step 2: Complete your registration and log in to the app.

Step 3 : Tap the “Add” button in the top right corner of the home page, then select “Add a device”. Follow the instructions to complete the network setup process.



Step 4: Allow the app to access Bluetooth and Wi-Fi. After the nearby device search, select your device and wait for the setup to complete. Your device is now ready to use.



5. Precautions

This section is intended to help users operate this voice recorder correctly and ensure optimal performance. Please read it carefully and follow it.

- Do not subject the device to strong impacts.
- Do not expose the device to chemicals such as benzene or thinners.
- Do not place the device near strong magnetic or electric fields.
- Do not immerse the device in water or place it near intense heat sources.
- Do not attempt to disassemble, repair, or modify the device yourself.

6. Built-in Battery Precautions

- Do not disassemble, strike, crush, or throw the battery into fire.
- If the battery swells significantly, stop using it.
- Do not place the battery in a high-temperature environment.
- Do not throw the battery away. To prevent environmental pollution, please recycle it properly.

7. Troubleshooting

If the recorder does not turn on: Check whether the battery is depleted. Connect the device to a computer or charger, then try turning it on again.

If you cannot download your files:

- Check that the computer and recorder are properly connected.
- Check whether the internal memory is full.
- Check whether the USB cable is damaged.

Additional Information

The memory capacity indicated at the factory may vary slightly due to different unit conversion methods. In addition, part of the storage capacity indicated on the device is used for formatting and certain system functions. As a result, the full advertised capacity is not available for data storage. The storage space actually available to the user may therefore be lower than the nominal capacity indicated on the product.

When charging the device with a power adapter, the user must use an adapter that complies with applicable standards.
